#### **Communication - Celeste**

- 3. New member welcome guide is almost complete.

#### Firewise Summary: (10 min) – Ken - Observation Ride Along with Chief Jackson - #6

- 1. PLS Chipping event is scheduled for July 20<sup>th</sup>. Later moved out a week.
- 2. Linda is working with Jeremy Baker (2-I-66) with regards to transferring this to him by years end.
- 3. Reminder to the membership to keep track of their time doing Firewise efforts, including travel time to/from their cabins. Time sheets are on the website and also at the clubhouse.

#### Technology Summary: (5 min) – Dave

- 1. Wi Fi Range Extenders coverage extended to the pool area
- 2. Extenders will be added for the lakeside deck.
- 3. A possible 3<sup>rd</sup> extender may be purchased.
- 4. No password required in the lodge area.
- 5. A Pineloch Sun weather station is up and running, the site is located on the website home page ans also the Facebook page

#### Road & Maintenance Summary: (5 min) –Loren for Ken

- 1. Removed tree limbs and other debris throughout Divisions 1 & 2.
- 2. Applied recycled asphalt to portions of Tom Write Road, damaged areas od Divisions 1 & 2 roads, and general repairs to Division 3 roads.





- 3. Double application of dust abatement throughout Divisions 1, 2 & 3.
- 4. Pool pump replaced pool is in good shape.
- 5. Corner blind spots will be taken care of.
- 6. Ditches and drain areas in Division 3 were cleaned for proper drainage.

### Water Summary: (5 min) – Mark for Robb

- 1. Water Storage Enhancement Goal 1 Sustainable storage during pump outage, Goal 2 enhanced treatment for odor control.
- 2. Next Steps Contact engineering firm for initial consultations (Loren) and verify water rights fort additional well at Division III pumping station (Loren/Robb).
- 3. PLS considering use of competitive bids for a Design Build Alternative 1 is a new 30,000 gallon tank at Division III pumping station. Alternative 2 is the installation of a new well to augment the current water supply.
- 4. A few water leaks were repaired.

### Architecture Summary: (5 min) – Bob

- 1. We have had 14 tree removal requests.
- 2. We had 1 House request.
- 3. We had 1 Shed request.
- 4. All were "Approved".

#### Membership Comments: All

1. Membership made comment on bringing a trailer up PLS roads, tree limbs Infringing on road, will drive roads and notate any hanging limbs.
