WI-FI RANGE EXTENDERS:

- Wi-Fi coverage extenders will be added for lakeside deck and pool area - when Lodge reopens.
- Passwords are not required in the Lodge area.

FIREWISE

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CHIEF JACKSON Observations

- Blind corners
- Vegetation right up to road edge
- Narrow roadways have evacuation plan for traffic flow out and emergency vehicle into community in the event of a wildfire; bolster turn out areas.
- Escape routes not marked plan escape routes for vehicles and foot traffic
- Emergency Warning Siren next to blue water tank Upper Highland Loop.
 Confirm it's operational.
- Standpipe housing structures GREAT! Confirm at least 100 feet of hose and nozzle.

CHIEF JACKSON Safety & Firewise Recommendations



- Develop and Communicate a PLS Evacuation Plan. Setup a phone tree to quickly and easily spread information amongst the PLS community.
- Research and complete a feasibility study for enhancing or adding additional egress paths to PLS Divisions 1 & 2. Potential location at the end of Dumbarton.
- Create a map identifying shed and PLS hydrant location.
- Ensure each shed has 100 ft of hose and is working condition.

FIREWISE

- Continue to reduce/eliminate ladder fuels
- Limb trees up to 30 feet; especially near corners to increase visibility for fire department as well as normal traffic conditions.
- Maintain a 10-foot buffer on each side of PLS roads creating a fire break, where and when possible.
- Continue to communicate, educate, and encourage PLS Members to "firewise" their properties.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF Natural Resources Per billion Consummaria










WATER

ROADS AND MAINTENANCE



ROADS & MAINTENANCE

- The Road material is ordered and the equipment is scheduled for May 26th. The first week is prepping the roads, then we lay the reclaimed material and try to put down the dust abatement the following week, weather permitting. Every PLS road has a layer and we are now replacing / repairing the worst sections first. We will prioritize the sections of road that need the material.
- Loren meeting with Ben Flowers w/ Wilderness Ridge Tree Service LLC to assess and identify dead and other trees along the road easement that require felling.
- Waiting on response / final decision on painting contractor bids
- Need to research and select and order pool furniture and will share findings with Board
- Our side project for the summer will be ditches in Division 3 and improving the "bypass road" down by the Tom Write gate.




